## A BYLAW TO LICENSE THE EXCAVATION OF GRAVEL FROM GRAVEL PITS

Saskatchewan enacts as follows: The Council of the Rural Municipality of Turtle River No. 469 in the Province of

- F. 0 "Premise" includes any pit, site or location within the municipality, in which gravel is naturally situated and from which gravel is excavated.
